



MoV Combined Foundation and Practitioner Course

Course Code	MOVC3
Overview	MoV focuses on improving benefits and reducing expenditure to speed up delivery without impacting essential project scope or service quality. It is not simply about minimising costs. MoV is more focussed on maximising value in line with programme or project objectives. It captures key stakeholder requirements for what products should do rather than what they are. MoV is essential to effective policy making, programmes, projects, service reviews or product redesigns.
	This course comprises four days of trainer-led instruction, and practical exercises, with the Foundation and Practitioner examinations.
Course Objectives	 The Foundation Course will enable delegates to: Demonstrate a knowledge of MoV principles, approach and environment; Explain the processes and techniques of value engineering and value analysis; Organise and contribute constructively to a Management of Value Study; Assist an MoV Professional to analyse a company, programme or project to identify and weight Value Drivers, and assess organisational value;
	 The Practitioner course will cover: Application of MoV studies in a portfolio, programme and project environment; Application of MoV studies in a Business as Usual environment; Embedding a culture of MoV in the Examination; Processes and Techniques to be applied when using MoV.
	Delegates will be fully prepared for the Foundation and Practitioner exams.
Who Should Attend	This course is suitable for individuals charged with maximizing the value of resources invested to get the best financial and non-financial benefits from portfolios, programmes and projects.
Prerequisites	There are no prerequisites for the course.
Course Content	Foundation topics covered include: Introduction: what is MoV and why it is needed; Value management and its place in organisational Best Practice; Principles underpinning value management; Processes and Techniques to be applied when using MoV; Approach to implementing MoV; Environmental factors influencing and impacting value; Application of MoV studies in a portfolio, programme and project environment; Application of MoV studies in a Business as Usual environment; Embedding a value culture in the organisation;
	The Practitioner Seminar is scenario based, and focuses on the application of MoV under different programme environments and scenarios. Review and revision sessions of all MoV elements are included throughout the seminar.
	The MoV Foundation Exam is a 40 minute closed book exam. There are 50 multiple choice questions. The candidate must correctly answer 50% or more of the questions to pass the exam.
	The MoV Practitioner Exam is a 2 ½ hour open book book exam; only the MoV Manual may be used. There are 8 questions per paper with 10 marks per question for a total of 80 marks. The candidate must correctly answer 50% or more of the questions to pass the exam. We conduct the exams on behalf of APMG.
	There will be homework each evening.
Included with the course	The MoV Manual; Foundation Delegate Workbook including activities, discussions, quizzes and sample exams; Practitioner Delegate Workbook; Our MoV Desk Reference Chart; Foundation and Practitioner Exams; Lunch, and morning and afternoon refreshments; Post-course support, including access to our alumni-only resources.
	A pre-course pack consisting of the Pre-Course Reading Guide and the MoV Manual can be sent to participants who complete registration at least 10 days before scheduled course start. We do recommend that participants complete 10 - 12 hours of pre-course reading, but this is not mandatory.
Delivery	In-house classroom-style over 3 days. eLearning and blended offerings coming.
Availability	We offer MoV training for in-house groups only, generally in association with adoption of value management practices.
