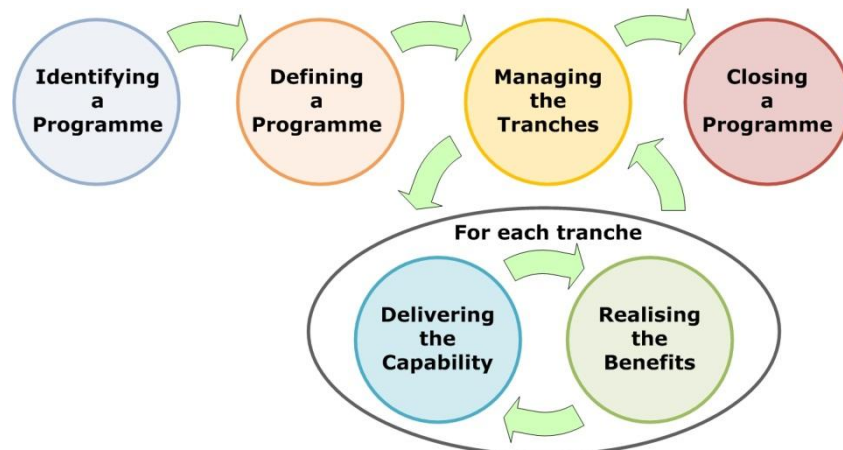

MSP Foundation Course

Course Code	MSPF3
Overview	The Foundation course provides participants with a solid Foundation in MSP concepts.
Course Objectives	By the end of the Foundation Course delegates will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Understand MSP's integrated elements and their relationships, building on delegates' own experience and knowledge of large-scale change; • Understand the benefits thread through MSP that ensures that the entire programme is predicated and focussed on realisation of benefits; • Understand how MSP could be applied in real life situations and undertake practical work in a supportive training environment; • Have received careful and detailed preparation for the Foundation Exam.
Who Should Attend	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Experienced Programme Managers who need to be able to work effectively in an MSP environment; • Senior Project Managers seeking an advancement to programme management; • 'Centre of excellence' staff who need a solid understanding of MSP to tailor the method for their organisations; • Strategy implementation planners who need an effective framework for planning and implementing major transformational change; • Project and programme support staff wanting to learn how to effectively operate in an MSP environment; • Anyone wishing to round out their resume with a formal internationally recognised programme management certification; • Project Managers and Programme Office staff keen to develop their skills and identify opportunities for further career advancement.
Prerequisites	There are no prerequisites for the course, however some exposure to programme management concepts would be useful.
Course Content	<p>The training is a scenario based training course focusing on the application of MSP under different programme environments and scenarios. Review and revision sessions of all MSP elements are included throughout the training.</p> <p>Topics covered include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The principles of programme management • The Governance Themes (Knowledge Areas) of MSP • The MSP Transformational Flow • Adopting MSP. <p>The MSP Foundation Exam is a 1 hour closed book exam. There are 75 multiple choice questions. The candidate must correctly answer 50% or more of the questions to pass the exam. We conduct the exam on behalf of APMG.</p> <p>There will be homework each evening.</p>
Included with the course	<p>Our Pre-Course Reading Guide. We do recommend that participants complete 10 - 12 hours of pre-course reading, but this is not mandatory;</p> <p>The MSP Manual;</p> <p>Foundation Delegate Workbook including activities, discussions, quizzes and sample exams;</p> <p>Our MSP Desk Reference Chart;</p> <p>Foundation Exam;</p> <p>Lunch, and morning and afternoon refreshments;</p> <p>Post-course support, including access to our alumni-only resources;</p> <p>A pre-course pack consisting of the Pre-Course Reading Guide and the MSP Manual will be sent to all participants who complete registration at least 10 days before scheduled course start.</p>
